4. The Department expects every officer in the service will recognize the importance of the duties attending his office, and will do all in his power to see that the Fisheries Laws are carried out, and that protection is given to the fisheries of his division.

5. Under Article 902 of the Criminal Code, all Justices of the Peace are obliged to make quarterly returns to the Clerk of the Peace, or other proper officer, of all convictions made by them and of the receipt and application by them of the moneys received from the defendants ; and the penalty for neglecting to make returns, or wilfully making incorrect returns, is *eighty dollars* and costs, which may be recovered by any person who sues for the same.

DIARY OF WORK AND ACCOUNTS OF  
DISBURSEMENT

6. Accounts in Diary, Form containing a complete record of all performed, must be rendered in duplicate at the end of each month, whether disbursements have been incurred in connection therewith or not. If no services have been performed, it should be so stated on the form, in which case the account need not be rendered in duplicate nor sworn to.
