- Driving wheels are larger than the majority of other Mowers, giving it a greater cutting power.
- The gearing is all enclosed, and thoroughly protected from dust.
- The bar can be adjusted at inner or outer ends, and is well adapted for rough ground.
- A combined shoe and wheel is used for carrying bar over furrows.
- The pitman box and shaft are made in such a manner that any operator can always keep them tight without any difficulty.
