**TWO QUAKES RECORDED EVIDENTLY WIDE APART**

Seismographs of U.S. Bureau Tell Tales of Earth Tremors That Cannot Lie.

Washington, Dec. 24.—A special bulletin issued by the United States weather bureau to-day says:

The seismographs of the weather bureau recorded two earthquakes of considerable magnitude; the first shortly after noon of the 22nd, and the second about 23 hours later, namely, afternoon of Dec. 23. From the appearance of the records we are led to conclude that the earthquakes originated at widely separated localities, but this cannot be definitely told.

The first tremors were recorded at 1:51.50 p.m. on the 22nd, and the maximum motion of very short duration occurred at 2:24 p.m. The strongest motion was recorded in a north-south direction, and amounted to 17 millimetres displacement. The maximum displacement in the east-west direction was only 3 millimetres.

The second disturbance was recorded just after 12 o'clock Dec. 23, and the motions in both north-south and east-west directions were greater in both components and lasted longer than in the first earthquake. The first preliminary tremor began at 12:57.35 p.m. The strongest motion was in a north-south direction, and lasted about 3 to 4 minutes. The maximum displacement in the east-west direction was 17 millimetres, and 7 millimetres for the north-south component. The end of the record occurred at 1:42.1 p.m.

As far as can be judged by the records, the second disturbance was not at so great a distance as the first one, but both disturbances must have been at several thousand miles from Washington.

**Mines Are All Closed.**

Goldfields, Nev., Dec. 24.—There were no important developments in the mines strike to-day. Nearly all the mines and leases are closed down, pending a settlement.

**HAMILTON HAPPENINGS**

**WANT CONSUMPTIVE SICK IN SEPARATE HOSPITAL**

Ladies Wait on Refuge Committee—Effort to Free Rioters—Tuckett Co. Distribute Cheer.

Hamilton, Dec. 24.—(Special).—This afternoon Messdames P. D. Crerar, William Southam and Robert Evans waited upon the House of Refuge committee to find out if the committee intended to make any provision for incurable consumptives with the \$30,000 the ratepayers will be asked to vote at the next municipal elections for a home for incurables. They explained that they did not want the hospital for the incurable victims of the white plague treated in the same institution as other incurables, but they promised to help carry the bill if the aldermen would devote some of the \$30,000 to the care of homeless cases of consumption. The aldermen appeared to be impressed, but made no definite promise.

**May Gain Freedom.**

Out of the 21 cases arising out of the street railway riots convictions were secured in only five cases. One prisoner was sent down for two months, two for one year, one for 18 months, and one for two years. An organized effort is being made to secure the release of all the prisoners, as it is argued that they are not ordinary criminals.

**John Dwyer, who broke into a farm house, and carried a boot into a church, was sent down for a year this morning by Judge Monk.**

Henry Clancy was this morning committed for trial on the charge of hitting William Harris' nose. His only defence this morning was that Harris had hit him on the hand.

**Service Cut Down.**

A number of the employees are temporarily thrown out of employment. The company says it expects to have the full service restored by Friday.

from now a traveler will be going to get his 1907 certificate from Mr. Sargent, the distributor of them at Toronto. Mr. Sargent will say: "What do you say your name is?" "John Smith, No. 14,985," probably will be the reply, and after going carefully thru the bundle of certificates his friend, G. H. Webster, has sent him, and finding there is no certificate for John Smith there will observe that the name does not seem to be there.

"What will I do?" The answer will be: "Oh! You better get your name on the poor John Smith will write Webster and after a short time will probably get a reply, saying: "For reasons it's unnecessary to state, I have decided not to renew your certificate for the new year." Then Smith will go to Mr. Sargent and he may say: "I am powerless. We can't afford to fight a battle for one man with these people. I don't want to lose the railway privileges of all the others in the association." Smith will probably say: "Good Lord, will I lose my \$1000 insurance?" "No," says Mr. Sargent, "you will no longer be a member. Your 1907 certificate ran out on Dec. 31st." It occurs to me that Smith, Jones and Brown want to join hands at once and employ a good smart lawyer and move for a writ of prohibition in this matter.
