MONTEPELIER FEARS. Big Building Strike Tying Up All Operations Probable.

Montreal, April 14.—The statement is made here that on Thursday or Friday one of the biggest strikes that has ever occurred in this city, involving about 2500 carpenters and joiners, will be inaugurated, paralyzing completely the operations of the city for a definite period. This opinion is freely expressed by the members of the brotherhood, who are emphatic in declaring that they will accept nothing less than 22 1/2 cents per hour, and there is a strong feeling that the original demand for 25c per hour should be adhered to in the event of no settlement being reached.
