New York, March 23.—Sidney Roberts Burleigh writes to The Journal from Canea, Crete, under Friday's date, the despatch having been delayed.

"I was an eye-witness of the assault and capture of the fort at Malaxa by the Cretons. The insurgents bravely faced the fire of the Turks, and showed no fear when bombarded by the Turkish warships. They held the fort for three days, until the whole European fleet opened fire and the block house was demolished.
