ARTHUR MISSION,

Which is about twenty-eight miles in length, has eight Sabbath appointments, two of which have preaching every second Sabbath regularly, the others at least once a month. I also preach occasionally on week nights, wherever I can get a congregation. We have one local preacher, one leader, three stewards, and a recording one; five classes, and thirty-eight members; twelve were lost by removals and changes, two of whom were local preachers, and one a recording steward; but we have gained nearly as many as we have lost. I have received \$38.00 for house-rent, horse-keep, and all other demands; yet through the condescending providence of God I am not in debt. Our worthy Elder helped me in cash. We have been reproached by debt, and I would rather want one meal a day, or a shirt, than add to this evil,—*reproachful evil*. I have good health, thank God, and have been enabled to always keep my appointments, excepting twice, occasioned by flood and heavy snow. I am sorry that I have not a better report to give. Some of those who removed from us were the best subscribers, therefore our funds suffer so much.

COLLINGWOOD MISSION.

This Mission is located in the Counties of Grey and Simcoe, and embraces parts of the Townships of Nottawasaga, Collingwood, and Euphrasia. There are six Sabbath appointments and two week appointments; five of the Sabbath appointments are in some of the most promising villages, viz., Collingwood town, Nottawa village, Thornbury, Creighleigh, and Williamstown. There are two chapels
