Too Many Bosses Lift German Costs

BERLIN, Oct. 8.—Excessive overhead in German production is due to too highly paid bosses, according to German trade unionists.

The unions have published statistics showing that more bosses are on the job now than in pre-war days. The number of workers in the iron industry has increased 13 per cent., while the number of directors has increased 62 per cent. Krupp, for instance, employed 30,000 workers before the war, 10 directors and 190 managers. They now employ 28,000 workers, 37 directors and 730 managers.
