**POLISH TROOPS ON WAY ACROSS LAND OF HUNS**

First Contingent Accompanied by Allied Officers — Warning to Germans.

Paris, April 16—(By the Associated Press)—The first contingent of General Haller's Polish troops started across Germany yesterday accompanied by British, French, Italian and American officers, who will act as liaison officials between the German and Polish troops.

Lissa, Posen, April 16—(By the Associated Press)—General Baron Von Hammerstein, a member of the German armistice commission, has telegraphed the people's council here saying that the Entente Powers had given assurance that General Haller's Polish troops would be used in merely maintaining order in former Russian territory vacated by the Germans.

General Von Hammerstein gives warning that it is a patriotic necessity that no difficulty be placed in the way of transporting these troops, that there be no German demonstrations along the way and that everything should be avoided which might lead to steps having most serious results.



**ST. JOHN MEN ARE COMING ON GRAMPAN**

45 Officers and 373 Other Ranks For This District—Some, Too, on Adriatic

The Grampian, which has sailed for St. John, has 434 Canadian soldiers and 779 dependents. Of the dependents 629 are women, 203 children and forty-seven infants. For the St. John area there are forty-five officers and 373 other ranks.

The steamer Adriatic with 106 officers and 1,721 other ranks, three nursing sisters and twenty dependents, will arrive at Halifax on or about April 20. Among them are four officers and sixty-one men of the anti-aircraft searchlight company. For St. John there are three officers and fifty-one other ranks; for Moncton, one officer and nine other ranks; for Charlottetown, one officer and five other ranks.

**NORTHLAND COOKS AND STEWARDS ONCE AGAIN ARE UNDER FIRE**

Calgary, April 15—W. J. Dyson, traveling representative of the Alberta Returned Soldiers' Committee, says that bitter protests have been lodged by the men who crossed on the Saturnia and that these are supported by the whole of the western men who reached Calgary on Monday evening.

It is said that the cooks and stewards of the Northland, who were cashiered from the Northland after a recent inquiry, were signed on the Saturnia, and the steamer had hardly left Liverpool before they commenced to "draw the coin" from the veterans.
