



THE TUBERCULOSIS HOSPITAL; A VISIT TO THE NEW SITE

Some of those interested in the erection of the hospital for advanced cases of tuberculosis paid a visit to the proposed new site on the municipal farm yesterday afternoon. The party was made up of Councillors Dean and Bryant, Commissioners Wigmore and McLellan, County Secretary Kelly, Doctors Melvin and McDonald, Mrs. James H. Frink, Mrs. E. A. Smith, Engineer Murdoch, F. Neil Brodie and A. M. Belding. The proposed new site, it was agreed by all, is a very desirable one, being on an eminence across the highway from the Municipal Home, and to the south of the Boys' Industrial Home. Water and sewerage can be procured without serious difficulty, and the site is on high ground with a fine outlook. One of the advantages mentioned in connection with the location of the hospital on this site is that the municipal farm could increase its live stock and poultry, and the new institution would have a near-
