uberculosis, announced today that the tuberculosis, announced today that the "vaccine consists of a homogenous emul-sion of live avirulent tuberculosis bacilli, in sterile distilled water. "The germ was isolated several years ago from a turtle and maintained ever since by transplantation on culture media, according to the usual procedure. The vaccine is administered to patients in doses of from cubic centimetres 0.10 to cubic centimetres 0.80 at intervals of from four to six weeks. Injections are

to cubic centimetres 0.80 at intervals of from four to six weeks. Injections are made introvenously in the case of joint tuberculosis and intramuscularly in the case of lung tuberculosis." He said: "Any physician in good standing is welcome to familiarize him-self at the various laboratories where the vaccine is prepared, with the details concerning the administration of the treatment that he may be able to use it personally on his own patients."


