

*Mistletoe Lodge.*

Q. Can the Executive undertake to pay sick benefits?

A. No.

*Newton Lodge.*

Q. How long can a candidate hold the doctor's certificate before presenting it to the Lodge for ballot?

A. Three months.

Q. If a member wishes to do without the doctor's services, can the amount paid the doctor per quarter be deducted from the member's dues.

A. No.

*Cambria Lodge.*

Q. Is it legal to admit a clearance member without medical examination? If such member falls sick, is the Lodge responsible for sick benefits?

A. It is not legal to admit a clearance member without medical examination, neither is the Lodge liable for sick benefits to members so admitted. Lodges must carry out the constitutional provisions in this respect.

*Lodge Shakespeare.*

Q. Is it legal for a President to have leave of absence from Lodge meetings?

A. No. If he be absent more than four times his office must be declared vacant and a new election held to fill the vacant position.

Q. Is a member, when under a charge, deprived of his privileges as a member?

A. Not until the charge be proven, except in criminal cases.

*Lodge Sussex.*

*United White Rose Degree.*

Q. Are members who do not belong to the benefit department in the W. R. Degree Lodge liable for dues for management expenses?

A. Members who subscribed to the by-laws must conform to their requirements, and would be liable.
