Worcester Sauce—Place in a large stock pan a moderate fire a good, heavy knuckle of fine white veal, with all the shanks or scraps of meat, including bones remaining in the kitchen (but not any game). Cover fully with cold water, adding a handful of salt, and as it comes to a boil be very careful to skim all the foam off—no particle of scum should be left on—and then put in two large, round, well-seasoned carrots, one whole, cleaned and sliced, round, one whole, peeled, large, round, onion, one whole, washed and sliced, three thoroughbred parsnips, and a few leaves of clean celery. Boil very slowly for six hours on the cover of the sauce. Skim the grease off then strain well through a wet cloth into a china bowl or a stone jar and put away in a cool place for general use.
