*Voted,* That Rev. George R. Neale be Chairman.

The Minutes of last year were then read and approved.

*Voted,* That Brother P. J. Hawkins be Clerk.

*Voted,* That Rev. G. R. Neale be Assistant Clerk.

*Voted,* That Deacon James Langford, of the Weymouth Church, be Secretary and Treasurer.

*Voted,* That Rev. H. Frances be Assistant Moderator.

*Voted,* That the Rev. B. Smithers and the Rev. G. R. Neale superintend the printing of the Minutes.

*Voted,* That they each receive five shillings for it.

*Voted,* That the Superintendents have power to correct any mistakes.

*It was voted,* That the Rev. Benson Smithers be Bishop of our Association.

*Voted,* That the Rev. Benson Smithers visit the churches once a-year. Adjourned.

Met at 11 o'clock. The Rev. George R. Neale preach the Introductory Sermon from Isaiah lii. 19 verse, followed by C. Roan and Rev. H. Frances and more of the brethren. Then we travelled to the water-side again, and the Rev. H. Frances baptized one old candidate 81 years of age, who was blind in bodily sight. Truly it was delightful to see him praising the Lord. The right hand of fellowship was given by the Rev. B. Smithers.

*Voted,* That Brother James Langford be Clerk for the Weymouth Church. Adjourned.
