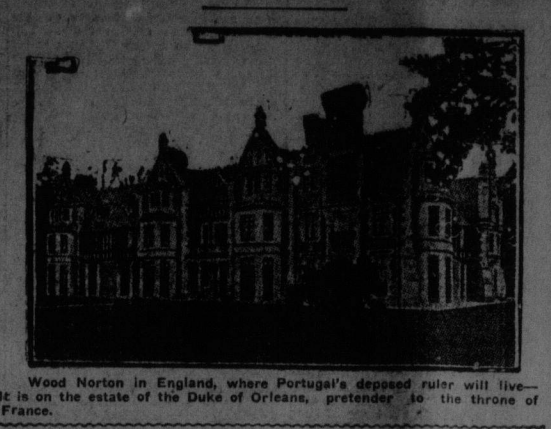

Letter from Boston Girl

Boston, Mass., June 17.—Are you a drunkard? If you are not quite sure this will help you to decide the question. The limit of sobriety has been designated by Dr. Richard Cabot in a lecture before the Massachusetts Medical Society. He defines an excessive drinker as one who indulges in liquor before breakfast; one who drinks three whiskey or more than one-half pint of the liquor per day; one who drinks two bottles or eight glasses of beer per day; and one who takes more than two drinks of gin per day. Also the use of more than one plug of tobacco per week, the smoking of three cigars or more or the use of 12 cigarettes per day qualify a person as an excessive tobacco user. Dr. Cabot's conclusions are based on years of expert investigation into the habits and effects of alcoholism and tobacco usage.

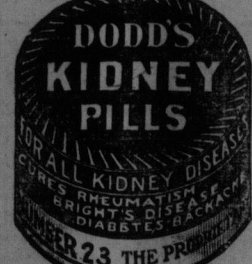
