Propeller Broken
New York, Jan. 13.—The American steamship Poughkeepsie, owned by the Shipping Board, was reported yesterday by the Lighthouse and the Hot Line Millas, to be in trouble about 1,000 miles east of Cape Henry. In a wireless message to the line here today the Captain Seifridge of the Millas said that he had taken the Poughkeepsie, which had the propeller blades broken in heavy weather, in tow Sunday morning, but under the stress of heavy weather the line parted. As soon as weather conditions permit another attempt will be made to tow the steamer to Hampton Roads.
Twenty-Three Days on Atlantic
The C. P. R. Freight Steamer War Peridot which docked yesterday morning at No. 6 berth, Sand Point, left London on December 20. Since the time of leaving London very little headway could be made on account of the very heavy seas and rough weather. Not until the vessel entered the Bay of Fundy did she encounter fine weather. This the mate of the steamer said was very unusual as it is usually in the Bay of Fundy where they encounter the rough sea. She brought over a general cargo and is in command of Captain Griffiths.
