SAN FRANCISCO IS THE LARGEST CITY IN CALIFORNIA. It has a Population of About 360,000, and is a Seaport of Great Commercial Importance.

The Union ferry depot, where the boats land which connect San Francisco with the railway systems across the bay, was erected by the state harbor commissioners in 1896 at a cost of \$1,000,000. It is 650 feet long, 150 feet wide, contains the railroad ticket office, waiting rooms, the California state board of trade, Pacific commercial museum and the state mining bureau.

The city hall, an imposing structure, built of brick, four stories high and cost \$1,050,000 and contains internal revenue offices, secret service and marine offices, as well as the United States circuit and district courts, the office of the appraiser and the office of the appraisers and the coast and geodetic survey.

There were in 1902, 4,002 manufacturing establishments, employing 88,103, 387 of capital, 4,041 salaried officials at \$4,619.93 per annum, and 41,978 wage earners at \$2,337.57 per annum. Of the laborers 272 were men, earning \$19,106.87, 9,231 were women, earning \$2,730,984 and 935 were children, earning \$135,964. The material used cost \$73,422,822 and the products were worth \$133,609,419. Some of the industries having a product amounting to or exceeding \$2,000,000 are the following: Sugar and molasses refining, \$42,448,148; 1903, slaughtering and meat packing \$9,991,551, foundry and machine shop \$8,368,969. The Union Iron Works employ about 4,000 men.

Most of the foreign commerce of the United States on the Pacific passes through San Francisco. In 1900 the city imported \$36,000,000 worth of goods from foreign countries, by sea, and exported by sea to foreign countries and Atlantic ports \$48,340,000 worth of goods. In 1902 there were entered at the San Francisco customs house from foreign and Atlantic ports 637,953 tons, and 420 steamships with a total tonnage of 923,717 tons.
