OPENING OF CANADIAN CONSULATE IN DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, today announced the opening of a Canadian Consulate in Santo Domingo and the appointment of an Honorary Consul in Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic.

The new consulate in Santo Domingo will provide improved consular facilities for the many Canadians visiting the Dominican Republic, expanded services for Canadian business and better service for Dominicans applying for visas to visit Canada. The new Honorary Consul in Puerto Plata will also be instrumental in extending Canadian consular assistance. In recent years, Puerto Plata, on the Dominican North Coast, has become the major destination for Canadian tourists going to the Dominican Republic.
