

cel or in two or more parcels, to such person or persons, party or parties as may be willing to become the purchaser or purchasers thereof, and that in such manner, whether by public sale or private contract, or partly by the one way and partly by the other, and at such times and at such price or prices, and on such terms of payment and security as to them 5 or a majority of them, as aforesaid, may seem best, and by a good and sufficient title or titles under their hands and seals, to convey the same, when so sold, to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, and, with the advice of the Presbytery of London, to apply the proceeds of such sale or sales and the sale or sales of such securities as may be taken by them, 10 as aforesaid, in the liquidation of the debts owing by the said Congregation, and also for the purchase of a piece of ground in Woodstock, and for the erection of a church thereon, to be held by the said Trustees, or by such a number of them as the said Congregation shall elect, in conformity with the provisions of the said Patent and their success- 15 ors duly elected, as aforesaid, in trust, for the benefit of the said Congregation, and to apply the surplus, if any, in or towards the building of a Manse for the Minister of the said Congregation or otherwise for the use of the said Congregation, as such Congregation, may decide; **Proviso.** Provided always that the Trustees who shall join in the sale and con- 20 veyance of the said lots, or of any portion or portions thereof, shall be personally liable to see to the application of the moneys arising therefrom to the purposes contemplated by this Act; but the purchaser or purchasers shall not.
