which said Lot of Ground, so soon as the same shall have been purchased and acquired from the present Proprietors thereof, at a price to be agreed upon by and between the aforesaid Proprietors and the persons herein above-named, and their associates, shall be and the same is hereby vested in them the said

and in their associates, their heirs, representatives and assigns, for ever, for the purposes of this Act, and as a public Market Place, and for no other purpose or purposes whatever.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said lot of ground, when the same shall have been duly purchased from the present Proprietor or Proprietors thereof by the persons herein above-named, shall be vested in the persons herein above named with their associates, their heirs, representatives and assigns for ever, who are hereby made and declared to be a Corporation, under the name and style of "The Corporation of the Market for the St. Lawrence Suburbs in the City of Montreal," for the special purpose of purchasing and being enabled and capable to hold in perpetual succession, the above-mentioned lot of ground, for the purposes aforesaid.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Corporation shall be and the same is hereby empowered, after the
