before the shipping or laping on Board the same, become bound, with other sufficient Security, in Tieble the Galue Security to be thereof, to the Commissioners of Chief' Officer of Officers of Customs. of His Majelly's Culloms belonging to the faid Poits of Bristol, Poole, Dartmouth, o: Exeter respectively, (who hath or have hereby Power to take such Security in Dis Wafeld's Dame, and to his Wafeld's Use), that such Commodities hall not be landed or fold in any Parts mhatsoever other than the said Island of Newfoundland; and that a Certificate under the hand and Seal of the Collector, Comptroller, or other Chief Officer of the Customs, or if no such, of the Maval Officer, or some bther Principal Officer there, thall, within the Space of Eighteen Calendar Wonths after the Date of such Bonds, (the Danger of the Seas excepted); be returned to the Micers who took the faid Bonds, that the faid Commodities have been landed in the faid Mand of Newfoundland; and for thet aking of such Security, and for giving such Certificates, (which the respective Officers aforesaid are hereby, on Demand, required to give), no Fee of Reward hall be demanded of received: And if officers making falle Cerany Officer shall make any falle Certificate of any such tincates, or eraing or fal-Commodities being so landed, such Micer thall fozfeit fifying fuch, fhall forfeit the Sum of Two hundred Pounds, and lose his Employe 2001. ment, and be incapable of ferping his Wajelly, his heirs or Successors, in any Office relating to the Customs; and if any Person hall counterfeit, rafe, or falusp, any fuch Certificate, or knowingly publish any fuch counterfeit. rafed, or falle Certificate, be shall forfeit the Sum of Two bundred Pounds, and such Certificate thall be void, and of no Effect; which fair Penalties foz Daences Penalties flow committed in Great Britain or Ireland shall be recovered in the same Courts, and in the same Wanner, as the other Penalties inflided by the said recited At are recoverable; and for Offences committed in the faid Island of Newfoundland, chall be recovered in the high Court of Admiralty, or in any Chief Court of the Civil or Criminal Jurisdiction in the faid Mand, and shall be divided into equal obvieties between this obajetly and the Informer; and the faid Bond or Bonds, if not profecuted within . 4 Q
