## A. Tariff Adjustments Requested by Southern Rhodesia

CORN - Free entry and exemption from dumping duty.

CITRUS FRUITS - Free entry, the same as accorded to Australia.

TOBACCO - Tariff preference.

PEANUTS - Same concession as extended to Australia.

Southern Rhodesia also requests change in direct shipment clause of the Canadian Tariff to permit export through the Port of Beira.
