



Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 31st ultimo, regarding the case of theft therein referred to, I beg to say that the Department can not retain the interest shares of Corbier et al and pay them over to Waubeneau and his son, but if Corbier, and the others persons convicted of the theft, give orders to you on their own initiative, to pay over their shares to Waubeneau and his son the Department would be willing to accept the same.
