I beg to inform you that representations have been made to the Department that the Indians of the Montana Band are desirous of cutting hay on the unsold portion of the surrendered land adjoining their reserve, and I have to request that you will be good enough to issue permits to the Indians to cut what hay they may require on any of these lands upon application being made to you.

Of course you will understand that permits are only to be given while the lands remain undisposed of by the Department.
