Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 1st of
February last, and to your letter of the 11th instant,
in regard to ground rent and royalties for an interest
of 1/2% on the value of certain blocks of timber in the
Township of James and adjoining an unincorporated town
and 10.81, in Canadian Indian Land, I have to inform you
that your estimate for that State's royalties have
not been received, and the 1/2% interest of interest
until these amounts shall have been received and the
due interest paid.

The Treasury Account is
to the honour of the Royal Bank here of 11th May
to the 11th of January last.

It has been reported to the
Department that you are wishing to relinquish the
rights you hold on certain lots in the Township of
James, in the South West corner of Township 1
to 10 to the North, and 1 to 10 to the West inclusive,
containing about 1000 acres, to the Department
which is in a position to make disposition of them.
