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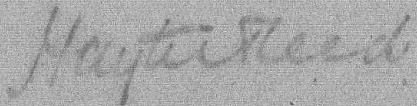
OTTAWA 27th October 1896

Rev: Sir,

I have the honor to call your attention to official letter of the 12th November 1894 respecting the maintenance of the Brandon Industrial school, in which you were informed that the Department would carry on the school for a year from the date of the commencement before handing it over to your Society to be conducted on the per capita basis.

The Department would be glad to know whether your Society is now prepared to take over the school and carry it on under the per capita grant, which will be \$110 for each pupil enrolled up to 80, in addition to which the Department will supply the necessary school material, medical attendance and repairs. This is the amount allowed the St Boniface and Elkhorn schools, while Qu'Appelle, which is 6 miles off the main line, receives only \$115.
