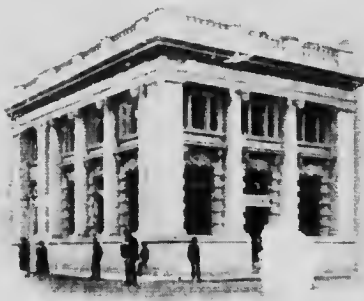


DESCRIPTION OF THE NEW BUILDING



THE new building, the ground floor of which is occupied by The Canadian Bank of Commerce, is two storeys in height and is constructed of Roman stone. The architectural design is free classic, a

style which has been adopted for a number of handsome buildings recently erected for the use of the Bank. The main entrance is on Dundas Street, and is flanked by two massive columns. It is but slightly raised above the level of the sidewalk, thus affording easy access to the banking room from the street.
