

The order of the day for reading the entries in the Journals, containing the information given to this House, on the 17th February 1808, concerning the Religion of *Ezekiel Hart*, Esquire, being read;

The said entries were accordingly read by the Clerk.

Mr. *Mondelet* moved, seconded by Mr. *Robitaille*, to resolve that the Members of this House, in whose presence *Ezekiel Hart*, Esquire, took the Oath, at the opening of the present Parliament, do inform the House, how he took the said Oath.

Whereupon Mr. *Mure* moved in amendment, seconded by Mr. *Blackwood*, to strike out all the words after the word "Resolve," and to substitute the following, "that this House will resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House, to morrow, to consider of the manner in which the Oath required to be taken by the Members of this House, before sitting and voting therein, was administered to *Ezekiel Hart*, Esquire, a Member of this House for the Borough of *Three Rivers*, at the opening of this present Parliament."

The House divided on the question of amendment, and the names being called for, they were taken down as followeth; *videlicet* :
