titled, "An Act to provide for the Maintenance and Government of the Provincial Penitentiary, erected near Kingston, in the Midland District."

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That an account in detail of the expenditure which may be incurred under this Act, of expenditure to shall be submitted to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person adberendered to the ministering the Government of this Province, at the next Session of the Legislature, and the monies paid by the Receiver General on such War- And the monies to rant or Warrants as shall be issued under the authority of this Act, shall be accounted for by the Receiver General. be accounted for to the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majesty, his Heirs and Successors shall be graciously pleased to direct.

CHAP. XLIII.

AN ACT granting a Loan to the Cobourg Harbour Company.

[Passed 16th April, 1835.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

WHEREAS it is expedient that a further Loan should be granted to Preamble. the Cobourg Harbour Company, to enable them to complete the said Harbour; we therefore beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, And be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Upper Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign, entitled 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be Loan of £1,000 to lawful for His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, or person administ the Company for tering the Government of this Province for the time being, to direct His four years, at six per cent. Majesty's Receiver General to loan to the President and Directors of the Cobourg Harbour Company the sum of One Thousand Pounds, for four years, at an Interest of Six per Centum per annum: Provided always, that before the said sum of One Thousand Pounds hereby authorised to
