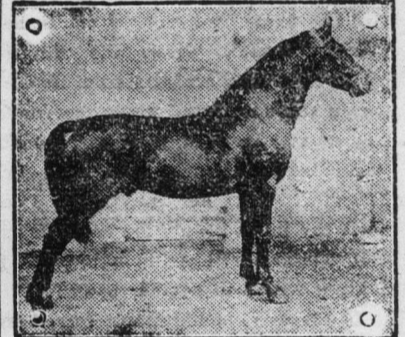
### Grand Opportunity For Farmers and Horse Owners.

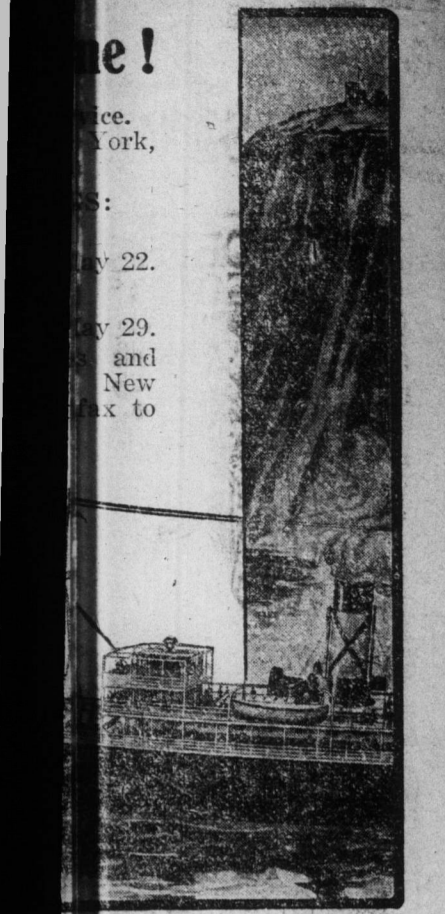
