Quittor is the name given to fistula which occurs at the coronate just above the horn of the hoof from which there is a discharge of pus caused by the irritation of some foreign body or dis-eased tissue within the hoof. It is attended by considerable swelling, lameness, and suppuration. It may occur in any horse's foot and it may be simply a single sinus in the laminae and coronate or it may communicate, with numerous sinuses running in all directions and not infrequently pro- ducing disease of the os pedis or its lateral cartilages. This latter condition proves very difficult to heal, and not infrequently becomes incurable.
