A BIG RESORT PLAN

CHICAGO MAN BUYS FAMOUS CALIFORNIA ISLAND

Wm. Wrigley, Jr. Heads Company Purchasing Santa Catalina Island. LOS ANGELES, CAL., March, 22—One of the biggest real estate deals ever put over in California is now an assured fact and details can be furnished by the interested parties.

Included in the transfer are practically all of the 48,000 acres of the island the new \$400,000, Ste. Catherine Hotel and its appurtenances, ten thousand head of sheep two large steamers which ply between San Pedro and the Island, a fleet of glass bottom power boats and other property of the Santa Catalina Island Company.

GREEK TROOPS DEFEATED THE BOLSHIEVK They Captured Prisoners and War Material at Kherson

SALONKI, Tuesday, March 18—Greek troops have defeated the Russian Bolsheviki at Kherson, north-east of Odessa, and advanced about twelve miles, according to an official announcement made today by Greek headquarters here. The Greeks captured prisoners and war material.

Geek troops were reported to have occupied Kherson in a despatch from Athens on February 26. An earlier despatch had reported that Greek and Roumanian troops had advanced north from Odessa in pursuit of the Bolsheviki. The fighting referred to in the Greek announcement probably occurred north of Kherson.

For several months French and British detachments have been in Odessa, but reports received in London today say the situation in Odessa was critical and that the Allied forces were retiring from the city. The report, which was not denied, could not be confirmed.

A Russian wireless despatch received in London on March 12 reported that Kherson had been captured on March 8 by Ukrainian Soviet troops. Kherson, which is ninety-two miles northeast of Odessa, is an important trading centre at the mouth of the Dnieper.

Situation in Odessa Critical

LONDON, March 19—Official reports received in London are to the effect that a critical state of affairs exist in Odessa, the chief Russian port on the Black Sea. No confirmation could be obtained in London early this afternoon to rumors that Odessa was being evacuated by Allied forces, but the report is not denied.

The International Paper Company of New York has decided upon the erection of a huge plant at Three Rivers, Quebec. Six million dollars, it is said, will be spent on this paper plant, that will be in the very heart of the wood and pulp industry of the valley of the St. Maurice River.

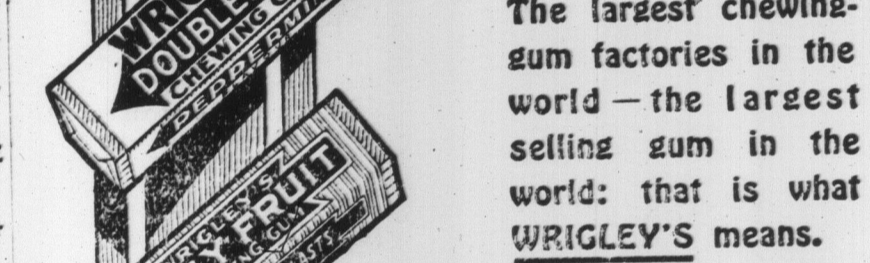
