TRAIL AND CAMP-FIRE.—The Book of the Boone and Crockett Club. Edited by George Bird Grinnell and Theodore Roosevelt. New York, Forest and Stream Publishing Company, 1898. Svo., cloth. 353 p., 14 photogravures.

The present volume is the third volume of the Boone and

Crockett Club. The two earlier ones are: "American Big Game Hunting", and "Hunting in many Lands"; they were published in 1893 and 1895, respectively. It is the purpose of the Club to issue one such volume every two years. The leading article in the present volume is that of our Canadian geologist, Mr. A. P. Low, of the Geological Departmen'; it is entitled: "The Labrador Peninsula". This paper contains some very interesting matter relating to the history, topography and geology of the Labrador peninsula. According to Mr. Low, Biarne, the Norseman, skirted the shores of Labrador in 990, he was followed by some other adventurers in 1347. "After a lapse of one hundred and fifty years, Labrador was re-discovered by John Cabot in 1497, on a voyage from Bristol..."

The book contains several other valuable papers for sportsman, viz: Cherry, by Lewis S. Thompson; An African Shooting Trip, by Wm. Lord Smith; Sintamaskin, by C. Grant La Farge; Wolves and Wolf Nature, by George Bird
