

and which is also otherwise interesting,
for the first time, it records several
species of Birds as being residents
of that region not mentioned by previous
writers, but space will not permit
us hereto give their names.

In volume V of the C. V. & G. there is no
article on Ornithology, except the one by
Mr. Vermer, and to this attention will be
directed in the next chapter, but all those
articles that we have reviewed were
carefully read by him, and did much to
stimulate his studies of the subject, and
prompt his avifaunian composition.
Here leaving this subject for future
investigation we append as the
line of Yonne Vermer's biographical
narrative.
