## PROVINCIAL REGISTER.

### HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY,

THURSDAY, 5 December.

The House met, and, after a short debate on a motion to take into consideration the state of the Highways and bridges, adjourned to Saturday, that the Committees on the Law and Militia Bills might expedite the work before them.

*Saturday 7.*—A Committee of seven was appointed to take into consideration the present state of the Highways and Bridges, and ordered to prepare and bring in a Bill for the better constructing and repairing the same.—A Resolve reported from the Committee on the establishment of Courts of Justice, touching the printing and further publishing for the instruction of the people at large, the Laws passed and to be passed by the Legislature of this Province, underwent a long debate without coming to a conclusion on the subject, and the House adjourned to Monday.

*Monday 9.*—The House continued the debate on the above Resolution, and finally ordered the Committee on the establishment of Courts of Justice to prepare and bring in a Bill thereon, and adjourned to Wednesday.

*Wednesday 11.*—The House adjourned for want of a quorum.

*Thursday 12.*—The House met, and nothing being before it, adjourned to Saturday.

*Saturday 14.*—The House met, and adjourned to Monday.

*Monday 16.*—The House resolved there should be no vacation the ensuing Holidays, and that it would only adjourn over Christmas and New Year's days.—Several Members asked for leave of absence and obtained it—then the House adjourned.

*Tuesday 17.*—A Petition from the Church Wardens and Vestry of Christ Church of Montreal was presented to the House, praying leave to introduce a Bill for giving effect to and making valid the Registry of Marriages, Baptisms and Burials in said Parish since the year 1775; and the matter of said Petition was referred to a Committee.—A Message was named to carry to
