as to make their calls at the three or four | the fire light shining through the half open other houses, which, with the station, formed the settlement of Savanne.

From this time we saw a great deal of our Indian friends, and began to learn their names and to find out about the different families. We often walked down they live, the hunger and fatigue and to their encampment, which was on the hank of the river near the station-house, and the scene was very picturesque, the bark wigwams among the fir trees with

"doorway.", the smoke curling up against a clear winter evening sky, the boys and girls playing on the ice—it all looked cheerful and pleasant

But when we think of the wretched way all manner of hardships they endure, one longs to do something to improve their condition.
