

(c) Any notification of accession under paragraph (a) of this Article shall include any dependencies or territories administered by the Government of the country in respect of which notification of accession is given. Any other provisions of this Convention shall apply to any such dependencies as if they were included in the notification of accession in respect of that country.

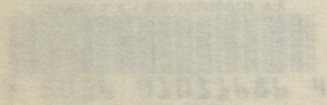
