The preceding chapters present a review.

Commission decided to carry out this control by road whenever water transport could not be made available to it.

Some of the Commission's teams in North Viet-Nam could not go out on their mandatory control duties when considered necessary on Sundays and holidays as the P.A.V.N. High Command did not make necessary arrangements on a number of occasions to enable the intimate Commission's teams to carry out these controls. Commission expressed its concern and requested the P.A.V.N. High Command to afford all possible assistance Similar difficulties were experienced and co-operation. by a few teams of the Commission in South Viet-Nam on a few occasions. The Commission requested the Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam to afford all possible assistance and co-operation to the Commission's teams in Commission's Fixed Teams, as mentice brager eithtraph 29.

The Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam maintained its interpretation of Article 14(e) and, as mentioned in paragraph 11, did not change its stand with regard to this Article. It did not co-operate in the investigation of complaints under Article 14(e). As mentioned in paragraph 15, the Mobile Team 103 of the Commission, in the discharge of its duty of investigation under Article 14(c), did not receive co-operation from the Government of the Republic of the period under relates to a period prior to the period under review.

The Government of the Republic of Viet-Nam

did not accept the Commission's interpretation of
