CeBIT is one of the truly international trade shows for the computer industry comprising office and information systems, bank and safety systems, software, consulting, DP-peripherals, office and organization technology, telecommunications, research and development, C-technics and operating data acquisition. In 1988, visitor attendance was recorded at 485 881 with 2 731 exhibitors from 36 countries. Combined on-site and 12-month estimated sales by Canadian companies in 1988 were expected to exceed \$41 million. Twenty-five Canadian companies are expected to participate in 1991.
