70305-1	<p>Baggage and conveyances temporarily imported by a person who is not a resident of Canada for his own use in Canada .....</p> <p>The Governor in Council may make regulations</p> <p>(a) prescribing terms and conditions on which goods or conveyances may be imported under this tariff item and authorizing the Minister to set such terms and conditions in specified circumstances;</p> <p>(b) limiting the quantity of any class of goods that may be imported hereunder and authorizing the Minister to increase any such limit in specified circumstances;</p> <p>(c) excluding any class of goods or conveyance from the operation of this tariff item;</p> <p>(d) limiting the length of time any goods or conveyances imported under this tariff item may remain in Canada, and authorizing the Minister to extend such limit;</p> <p>(e) authorizing the Minister to require security for goods or conveyances imported under this tariff item and limiting the amount and type of security that may be required; and</p> <p>(f) defining the term "resident" for the purpose of this tariff item.</p> <p>Goods entitled to entry under this tariff item shall be exempt from all imposts, notwithstanding the provisions of this or any other Act of Parliament.</p>	Free	Free	Free
