The following answer, deposited with the Clerk of the house, is printed in the official report of debates pursuant to standing order 39:

GRAHAM MOSES

Question No. 507-Mr. Argue:

1. Is a Mr. Graham Moses, presently employed by the Canadian government in any capacity?

2. If so, in what department, on what date was he appointed, by what authority, what are his duties, his salary, and what qualifications has he for this position?

3. On what date did Mr. Moses first enter government employment, what positions has he held, the date he took up service in each, and where has he served?

4. Were all of these appointments made through a civil service competition?

5. If so, what was the date and number of the competition?

6. If not, which ones were not, under what authority were they made, and on what date?

7. What moneys have been paid by the Canadian government to Mr. Moses in (a) salary; (b) expenses, each year since his first appointment, to January 1, 1959?

Answer by: Hon. Raymond O'Hurley (Minister of Defence Production):

1. Yes.

2. Employed by Defence Construction (1951) Limited, June 14, 1955. Authority: section 7, Defence Production Act. Duties: presently project manager at Frobisher Bay, Baffin island, Northwest Territories, responsible for supervision of all construction work on refuelling facilities project. Salary: it has not been the practice to make available

the salary arrangements or remunerations paid to crown company employees. *Qualifications*: twenty-nine years' experience in construction industry, specializing in metallurgy, steel erection and fabrication, welding, underground steam distribution systems, reinforced concrete, and supervision of large multi-building projects.

3. First entered government service when employed by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation January 2, 1952, as a construction inspector at the corporation's branch office in Ottawa; was employed by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation until March 31, 1953.

Mr. Moses was hired by Defence Construction (1951) Limited, on June 14, 1955.

Positions held: June 14, 1955—project engineer, head office, Ottawa, Ontario. July 9, 1955—zone engineer, Winisk and Moosonee, Ontario. December 1, 1957—project engineer, head office, Ottawa, Ontario. September 13, 1958—project manager, Frobisher Bay, Baffin island, Northwest Territories.

6. Appointment as construction inspector C.M.H.C., under authority of the Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation Act, section 14 (1). Taken on strength January 2, 1952.
