

**The Acting Speaker (Mr. Paproski):** Is the House in agreement that the division be taken by rows?

**Some Hon. Members:** Agreed.

**The Acting Speaker (Mr. Paproski):** We will then proceed as follows: As is customary, Hon. Members in favour of the amendment will be asked to indicate their position first, followed by Hon. Members who are opposed.

I will ask all Members in the first row to my right who are in favour of the amendment to rise together, whereupon their names will be called by a Clerk, beginning with the Hon. Member seated closest to the Chair. When the name of a Member in the row has been called and recorded, that Member will resume his or her seat.

When the taking of the names of Hon. Members in the first row to my right has been completed, I will ask Members in the second, third, fourth, and fifth rows on my right to proceed in a similar manner.

I will then ask Members in the first row to my left, regardless of their Party affiliation, who are in favour of the amendment to rise and remain standing until their names have been called. We will carry on similarly with other rows on my left.

Once the votes of Hon. Members supporting the amendment have been completed in this manner, I will then invite Hon. Members in the first row to my right who are opposed to the amendment to rise. I will proceed similarly through the remaining rows to my right and follow the same procedure for Hon. Members to my left.

Order, please. It has been a long day. This is the first time that this type of voting procedure has taken place—

**Some Hon. Members:** It is the second time.

**The Acting Speaker (Mr. Paproski):** It is the second time, but I was not here the first time.

It bears repetition that the taking of names of Hon. Members in every row will begin with the Hon. Members seated closest to the Chair and will continue consecutively to the far end of the row. This will be so to my right, regardless of rank. It will also be so to my left, regardless of rank or Party affiliation. The question is on the amendment.
