OFFICIAL LANGUAGES ACT

MEASURE TO ESTABLISH

The House resumed consideration of Bill C-72, an Act respecting the status and use of the official languages of Canada, as reported (with amendments) from a legislative committee.

Mr. Speaker: Pursuant to order made Monday, July 4, 1988, it is my duty to put forthwith every question necessary to dispose of the report stage of this Bill.

Mr. Gauthier, seconded by Mr. Guilbault (Saint-Jacques) moved that Bill C-72, an Act respecting the status and use of the official languages of Canada, be amended in Clause 2 by striking out line 40 at page 2 and substituting the following therefor:
