THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-9.

An Act for the relief of Susanne Louise Eismann Weinfield.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Susanne Louise Eismann Weinfield, residing at the city of St. Laurent, in the province of Quebec, wife of Mortimer Weinfield, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of Montreal, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the 5 thirtieth day of March, A.D. 1948, at the city of Westmount, in the said province, she then being Susanne Louise Eismann; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have 10 been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved. **1.** The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall 15 be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
