

CHAPTER VI COMBINATIONS OF COLOURS

the colour of colour and to take it for granted that the new names will have the colour. Only a few names of colour are formed directly from the root—red, yellow, green and blue may be cited—but even these names may have reference to some object or name. All other names of colour are derived from nature.

1st, *proper names*—peridot, cherry, straw, berry, pratincole, olive, moon, apple green, emerald, lime, citron, lemon, yellow.

2nd, *proper names*—violet, pink, rose, Edotrope, winter, mallow, ice, cold, primrose, yellow, blue, ivy, mononette, tenuis, rose, red, white.

3rd, *proper names*—hazel, nut, hazel nut, only for brownish green.

4th, *proper names*—yellow, red, blue, steel, grey, red lead, copper red, fine white, pearl Spanish for mire or old.

5th, *proper names*—emerald, apple green, turquoise, garnet, turquoise, lime, lapis lazuli, pearl grey, pearl blue.

6th, *proper names*—terra cotta, terra di siena, terra cotta, chrome yellow, chrome orange, terra verde, cobalt blue, mineral grey,umber, ochre.

7th, *proper names*—oil, oil mil, substance—sepia, crocodile, titians, Antillean, Wathles, tawn, ibis, illuna, ivory, black, canary yellow, robin egg blue, elephant green, seal brown, dove, salmon, chamois.

8th, *proper names*—persons—Bismarck (orange brown), Jeni Bart (dark blue), Van Dyke brown, Van Dyke red, Rembrandt red, Dray's grey, Payne's grey, Ophelia, Sappho, Victoria green.

9th, *proper names*—places—

a) countries and districts—Gamboge, Quito, Egyptian, Labrador, Havana, Siam, Palestine (dull pink), Sauterne, African green, Helvetia, Magenta;

b) nations or tribes—Italian pink, Judee, Zulu, Prussian blue, Chinese white.
