## A.

- to be able to compete with somebody, N.* lä'kyusta (—usta, up); wî-kyusta, *not to be able to get up against* (wî, negation; —usta, up) = *to rise opposite to somebody?*
- about, —uilli(la); N. tlé'kuillila, moving about; lâkuillila, camping about, here and there (lEku'la, to camp).*
- above, N. L. aikh, aikya; H. G. aikh; N. aikyak'au'ë, uppermost (—k'auë, farthest in a certain direction); L. ai'kyaqala, from above (—qua, down; —la, verb. suf.); L. aikyak'ë'mhit, to look up (—k'E'min, surface of round thing = face; —hit, v. a.); tläg-k'o-it aikh, evening sky = red above; G. au'kyoa, upper side (see *On top of*); H. mä'tea, to fly above.*
- to abuse one another, H. laa'lk'au.*
- to ache, L. ts'ë'hila (see *Sick*).*
- across, N. —uitla(la); lâ'lauitlala, or lâ'ludtla, always going across (lû—, to go).*
- Adam's apple, H. k'öök'ooqä'oa (—qäoaa, neck).*
- adrift (see *On surface of water*).*
- adze, H. tlä'k'ocabala (same type as the Pacific Island adze); towal'ü (D-shaped handle with blade attached to its flat side); tlë'q-kautl.*
- afraid, N. ky'ë'lala; L. ky'ë'lten, I am—; H. wô'se; wô'senô'gua, or lenô'gua wô'sile, I am—.*
- to make afraid, N. ts'ë'ntiyim; ts'ë'ntikya, to be—.*
- after, behiud, N. e'leqtlë; lâ'tlin, E'laqtlii, I will go after him.*
- afternoon, H. tlkyâ'qa.*
- again, N. hë't'ët; è'tëlis, again in each.*
- ago, long ago, L. k'aiü'tlul; H. k'aiü'tlul'ats (—ats, distant, invisible).*
- agreeable noise, H. aikh'ë'kala (aikh, good; —kala, noise).*
- ahead, N. lalak'a, to go ahead; (lak'a, to pass by, from; la, to go; —ka, reaching); Lâ'la-k'ayü'k'oa, name of female = made to go ahead.*
- air, H. nâ'la.*
- alder, N. tlä'k'omis (tlä'k'ö, red; —mis, tree); H. G. tlä'k'ötas (from : red).*
- alive, N. k'o'la; k'o'lasta, water of life (—sta, water).*
- all, L. k'ë'laue, N. nâ'qua, H. ägy, G. wâ'quau; that is all, L. lem-k'ö'la, H. au k'ö'äl.*
- alone, N. nâ'nawa; nâ'awalaqisë'-aq'ënoq, one who wants to work alone; H. némö'k' (ném, one); Nemö'kuis, the only one on earth; Nemö'kyustâlis, the only one who came up out of earth (—usta, up; —lis, ground); Nemö'kua, alone on rock (—a, stone, rock); Nemö'kuak'amë, all alone on rock (—k'amë, superlative); Nemö'kuitsâlis, alone on prairie (—itsâlis, flat open country).*
- to eat, drink, work alone, N. na'quila.*
- along, N. —nta(la).*
- long object, N. —nütSENTALA (long side of); k ätsnütSENTÄLA, to walk along long object.*
- flat object, N. —unqENTALA (—inqë, edge); k ä'senqENTÄLA, to walk along flat object; H. tönö'olsa, to walk along plank.*
