

Reports received by Rear Admiral R. B. Bradford, chief of the Bureau of Equipment, show that the Nero first proceeded directly to the Midway Islands, sounding on the way, and then zig-zagged across the line to determine the best points to locate the proposed cable. From the Midway Islands the Nero went to Guam, From Guam the Nero steamed to Manila, then returned to Guam, and later went to Yokohama, where she is now preparing for the return voyage. She will zig-zag across the Imaginary line drawn during the voyage from Guam to Yokohama, making furtner sounding from Guam to the Midway Islands and again to Honolulu. No adverse reports have been received concerning the route from Guam to Manila and from Guam to Yokohama, and the authorities are confident that no obstacles exist that can prevent the laying of a cable from San Francisco to Manila, touching everywhere on American soil.
