with the housing commission. Four plans for a new Ridout street bridge were considered, three by City Engineer Brazler, and one by F. G. Engholm of Toronto. This matter will be discussed next Tuesday.

Arrangements for paving a number of principal streets have been made, and storm sewers and other such work must be completed first. To do this \$250,000 will be required in addition to the remainder of \$100,000 which was voted for the work some time ago. time ago. The sections included are Wellington

road and High street, \$61,500; London South, \$51,841; London West, \$50,000; William street, \$32,560; Maltiand street, \$25,500; Colborne street north, \$44,900; Hemilton road, \$41,250; Dundas street, citizens vote on the establishment a municipal depot adjoining the municipal paving plant at Bathurst and Adelaide streets. Engineer H. A.

Brazier estimates this will cost \$85,000. The members of the committee were unanimously agreed that this should be established.

Equipment Left Outside.

At present all the city's watering carts, street cleaning equipment and other material is left exposed to the elements in a vacant lot. There are no proper repair shops or buildings for the storage of construction material. If this plan is adopted brick buildings will be erected for these purposes.

"We ought to spend more on things like this in the city and not so much on the railroad," said Ald, Keene.
