Athens, April 20. - (6 p.m.) - All the members of the gendarmerie and other police forces, military organized, are now going to the frontier. The citizens have volunteered to guard the town and the same state of affairs prevails in the other towns of Greece. On all sides there is a firm determination to resist the Turkish invasion, and every man who can be spared and who can bear arms is going to the front. The Athenian ladies, under the patronage of the Queen, have converted the steamer Theodosy into a floating hospital. Three hundred beds for the wounded have been fitted up on board and she is now proceeding to Volo.

All Greek Citizens Meet. Headquarters of the Greek Army in Thessaly, Larissa, April 20. - The Mayor of Larissa has issued a proclamation, calling upon all citizens to arm themselves in defence of the country. Every step possible is being taken to defend this place against the Turks, who are reported to have captured Tyrnovo, ten miles from here, and to be pushing on to Larissa. WHAT THE TURKS CLAIM. Say They Have Repulsed the Greek Fleet at Prevesa. Washington, April 20. - According to official despatches received by Mustafa Bey, the Turkish Minister, from Constantinople, under date of April 20, the Turks have not only gained some slight advantage along the north-western frontier in the neighbourhood of Milouna Pass, but have repulsed the attack of the Greek fleet on Prevesa. The enemy retreated to the Plain of Thessaly, leaving only a rear guard on a hill from which it was driven later by four battalions of Turkish infantry.
