PEACE FLYING, SAY EXPERTS, NOT FOR THE YOUNG MAN ONLY

London, March 30—(Correspondence of The Associated Press)—The fact that only young men capable of passing severe physical tests were accepted for aviation work during the war has caused the belief that flying as a sport will be barred to persons past the prime of youth. That is a mistake, according to British experts, who say that for ordinary peace-time flying there should be no age limit. The only qualifications they set are good eyesight and a sound heart.

Flying an airplane, it is pointed out, is much simpler, and far less nerve-racking than driving an automobile or sailing a yacht. Experts say that any man who has lived a decent open-air life, especially if he has played games and hunted, will find that learning to fly, even at the age of fifty, is quite an easy business. A modern airplane will virtually fly itself, and the controls are so arranged that a man, even on his first trip, it is argued, does the right thing instinctively.

In the early days of the war fully fifty per cent of British airmen were above thirty years old. As the art of aerial warfare developed the pilot had to prove himself proficient in bombing, wireless telegraphy, formation flying, cloud navigation and the numerous stunts that became essential for the fighter. 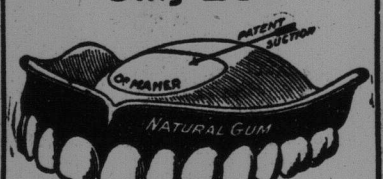

OFFICIAL STATEMENT ON SITUATION IN INDIA

London, April 17—The India office last night issued the following statement regarding the situation in India:

"Official reports are to the effect that all is quiet at Amritsar, Lahore and Bombay. At Virangam there have been serious disturbances. Government build-

ings were destroyed and an Indian revenue officer was killed, but order has now been restored.

"There were slight disturbances in Calcutta on the eleventh and twelfth. The military was called out and fired on the crowd and six persons were killed and twelve wounded."

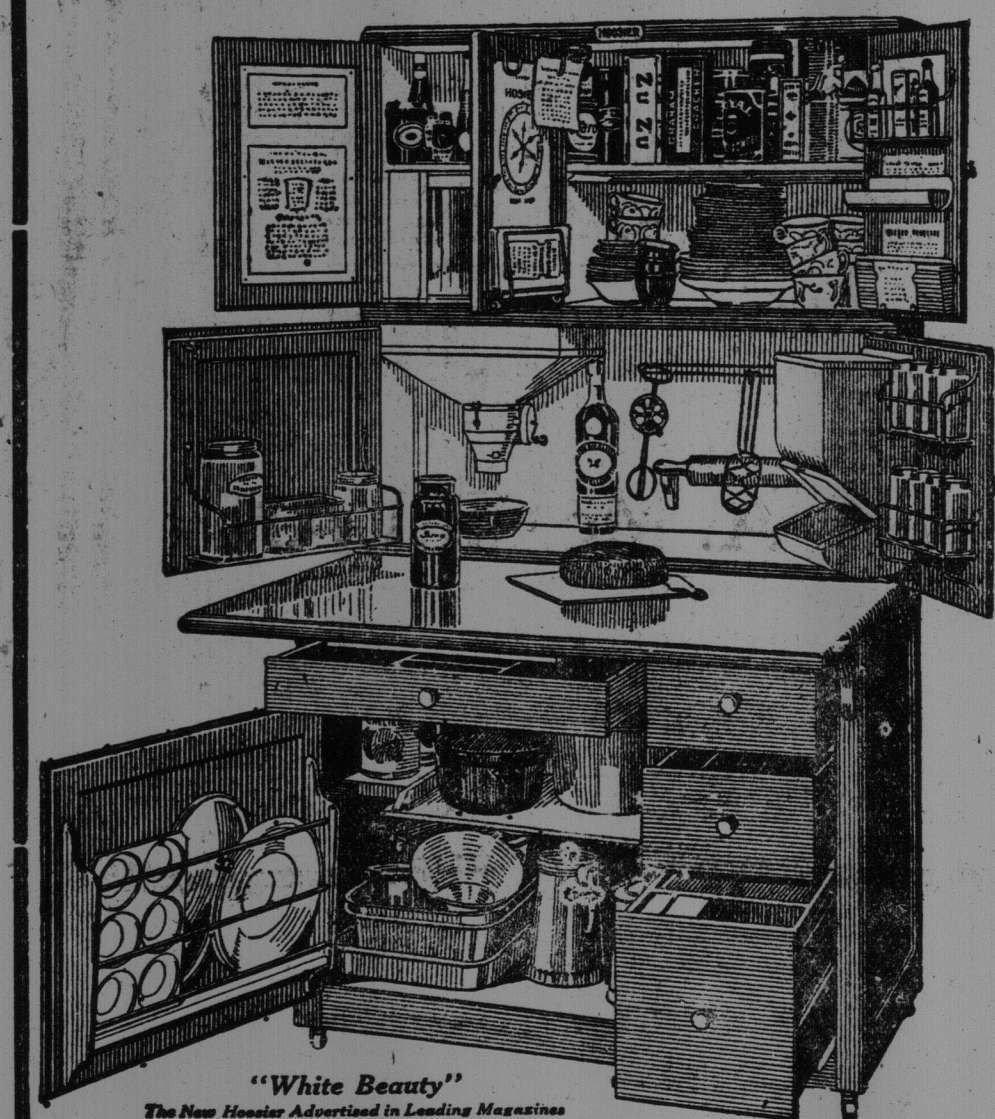
