TAKE MORE INTEREST IN POLITICAL AFFAIRS
 (Woman's Journal.)
 One of the effects of woman suffrage in the State of Washington is the tremendous increase of interest on the part of women all over the state in social and economic problems, writes Leo Jones, secretary of the Bureau of Debate and Discussion. Extension Division, University of Washington. This is evidenced by the change in the type of subjects which many women's clubs are discussing. There is a decided tendency of these organizations to select for their chief study topics such as "Woman and Child Labor," "Poverty," "Eugenics," and "Vocational Education," rather than such subjects as "Byzantine Art" and "Oriental Rugs."
 The same increase of interest in public questions among a younger group of women is shown by the activities of the women students of the University of Washington. Every year a relatively larger number of women take courses in economics, sociology and related subjects. The women's debating activities are better supported by the women of the university than are the men's debating activities by the men, considering the fact that there are over one-third more men than women attending the university. The women have two debating clubs, the men two. The women have three intercollegiate debates, in which seven women participate; the men have four annual intercollegiate debates, in which eight men participate. Inter-club debates are held annually, of which the women debaters usually win a large percentage. The questions which the women are debating this year are "Minimum Wage," "Restriction of Immigration," and "International Conciliation."
 Most of this interest has developed since 1910, when Washington became an equal suffrage State, and much of it can be attributed to the participation of women in political affairs.
